A VISION THAT SCULPTS PROGRESS

The state of Gujarat is steeped in the centuries-old tradition of sculpting and is rich in stone deposits; providing a conducive environment for SAPTI. Shri Narendra Modi, as the then Hon'ble Chief Minister of Gujarat, envisioned SAPTI to aid the broad section of society, including the tribal youth by offering them opportunities of acquiring education and professional skills - leading to employment in the stone sector. SAPTI offers free education with quality boarding and lodging facilities. Founded in 2009, SAPTI carries forward the valuable heritage of stone art, craft, and architecture shaped in famous Ambaji White Marble (GI Tagged) and Sandstone of Dhrangadhra.

Through our vocational programmes, we aim at empowering the youth of Gujarat as an initial goal; eventually seeking enrolment from all over India for training in stone arts and crafts. On completion of the various vocational programmes at SAPTI, students would have honed their abilities in manipulation of stone by hand carving, turning on lathe, and through CNC design and operations, leading to becoming independent professionals and entrepreneurs.

IMPARTING SKILLS TRAINING IN STONE

SAPTI is duly approved by and affiliated with Kaushalya-The Skill University. In addition, many 3-6 month short term course are under approval process with Gujarat Council of Vocational Training (GCVT). SAPTI instils in its students basic to advanced level learning of drawing, sketching, drafting, design, and stone manipulation skills, which are proportionally aided by theoretical subjects such general art history and method/material of stone, languages, communication skills etc. Students develop proficiency in the use of various tools and techniques, including conventional carving by hand tools, handheld power tools, pneumatic tools, cutting edge machines, lathe turning, CNC operations, welding/brazing, etc. while following strict safety precautions.

Aspects such as costing, packaging, marketing, display, entrepreneurship are purposefully embedded in our education, in active collaboration with professional groups, industries, initiatives of the Government of Gujarat, and central government schemes. These activities are aimed at providing our students with internship, employment, and entrepreneurial opportunities.

MODERN SETTINGS, STIMULATING ENVIRONMENT

SAPTI has set high standards of infrastructure that reflect its aspirations and ambitions. Both Ambaji and Dhrangadhra campus provision wide-open landscape with clean, uncluttered spaces amidst greenery. All buildings on campus comprising classrooms, library, computer lab, workshops, hostels (120 candidates), office spaces, recreational areas, staff accommodations, working units, cafeteria, amenities, and conference halls are either newly constructed or retrofitted to match present-day standards. All artefacts created by students are befitting displayed in display galleries and in open-air, inspiring prospective students on their maiden visits. A retail shop is set on campus for display, sale, and retail simulation of students. Special guesthouse facility for visiting professionals, sculptors, experts, etc. has been additionally provided.

The classrooms, workshops, and computer lab are well equipped with audiovisual equipment, industry-standard machines/tools and most updated computer workstations with relevant software. A well-furnished library, stocked with books, magazines and relevant CDs, further enhances the learning environment at SAPTI. First-aid kits are placed in classrooms and workshops with provision of on call doctor and hospital visit in case of emergencies. Both the centres have dedicated bus for regular excursions to historical places related stone sculptures/architecture and for industrial visits.

SAPTI will act as a progressive beacon for the stone craft traditions and promote its aesthetical assimilation with present day requirements, generate revenue, and enhance employment by imparting stone craftsmanship among the interested youth.

CHISELLING TALENT INTO SKILLS

Diploma of Vocation in Stone Craft & Design (Duration: 24 Months)

- Minimum educational qualification is set at 10th standard pass.
- The maximum age limit is set at 28 years.
- Interest in stone arts and crafts is desired but not essential.
- The duration of the course has been divided into 4 terms of 6 months each. Further, each term is divided into 2 modules. SAPTI will certify students and the end of each module. In case a student exits the program due personal exigencies, he may resume the at the stage later. The structure of the programme has been designed in such way that a student develops his skills from beginner, intermediate, proficient, and eventually to advanced stage.

Learning Outcomes:

- Students will develop proficiency in freehand drawing, technical drafting, clay modelling, plaster casting and carving, manual stone carving, carving with power tools and pneumatic tools, turning of stone on lathe, CNC design and operations.
- Students will develop communication skills (verbal and written), with introduction to computers and CNC based design/operation software's.
- Students will develop an understanding of the Art History and Methods/Material of stone as a sculptural medium.
- Students will participate in a compulsory, month-long Practical Training Programme at a SAPTI partnership industrial centre or workshop under the guidance of a mentor.

SAPTI also offers 3-6 month short terms course in Lathe and CNC Design & Operations.

SAPTI has signed several MoUs with academic institutions such as CVM College of Fine Arts – Anand, Kaushalya – The Skill University, Hemchandracharya North Gujarat University, Regional ITIs, NCC, and Federation of Indian Granite & Stone Industry being prominent among other institutes

FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS

Who is eligible for the various courses offered at SAPTI?

SAPTI opens its doors for candidates interested in pursuing a career in stone artisanship and design with a minimum 10th pass qualification for the 2 Yr Diploma of Vocation in Stone Craft and Design. For short term courses, the minimum qualification is set at 8th pass. The maximum age limit is set at 28 years.

- When will the Programme begin?
 Biannually, in June-July and December- January.
- Is there any Programme Registration Fees?

 One-time registration fee as set by Kaushalya The Skill University.

The programme is completely free otherwise.

Poes SAPTI award Certificates to its students?

Yes, successful students enrolled in the 2 Yr Diploma of Vocation in Stone Craft and Design will be awarded Diploma by Kaushalya – The Skill University, which are duly approved by AICTE and Government of Gujarat.

Examination

Students will be evaluated at the end of each term/module through displays, viva voce, mentor reports, MCQ and written exams. The students will be required to maintain 80% attendance to be eligible for examination.

Does SAPTI have a competent faculty?

Yes, SAPTI has highly qualified, experienced faculty possessing education and experience in the field of stone sculpture, craft, and design. Experts from academia and the stone industry ware also regularly invited to enhance subject-specific training.

Is SAPTI only enrolling candidates from Gujarat?

SAPTI is currently accepting registrations from interested candidates from across India as per the Government of Gujarat of admission reservation policy.

Will students get internship opportunities?

Yes. Practical Training/Internship Programmes are an integral part of all training programmes to be offered at SAPTI.

Does SAPTI promote entrepreneurship?

Yes. The training programmes at SAPTI will include structured classes that emphasise and educate students about entrepreneurial opportunities and encourage them to become independent craft artisans or craft entrepreneurs.

Will students receive any additional assistance after enrolling?

Besides providing free residential education and meals, SAPTI will provide working materials, stationery and safety kits, free of cost to students.

Will stone artisans get opportunities to work abroad? Yes, when opportunities arise, candidates will be able to showcase their work by participating in international exhibitions, crafts and art festivals. SAPTI will support the bright and talented candidates to promote their stone artisanship.

BEYOND TRAINING - THE SHILPOTSAV INITIATIVE

As part of the aesthetical reclamation and beautification initiatives of public spaces and promotion of stone sculptures, SAPTI envisioned and successfully organized SHILPOTSAV, a unique and comprehensive cultural activity intended to preserve and propagate the art of stone sculptures. Since June 2022, under the aegis of SHILPOTSAV, 6 stone sculpture symposiums have been organized by SAPTI, inviting students, upcoming, senior, traditional, and international sculptors from India and abroad. In doing so, SAPTI has accumulated a collection of 101 sculptures ranging from 4 ft. to 20 ft. in height. Sculptures from SHILPOTSAV symposiums have been permanently displayed at the Parikrama Path of Gabbar Hill Shrine, and at Ambaji Miyawaki Park, developed by the Gujarat Forest Department in the vicinity of Gabbar Hill Shrine. Likewise, sculptures from SAPTI symposiums have been installed in various public spaces overseen by Gandhinagar Municipal Corporation, Public Parks, Gujarat Vidhan Sabha, and the New Gujarat Police Commissionerate in Ahmedabad. Considering it an achievement to organize quality sculpture symposiums in such a short time, SAPTI received a certificate of membership from ISSA - International Sculpture Symposium Alliance for its exceptional ability to organize stone sculpture symposiums.



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GIVING FORM TALENT – AAKAR

On 15th August 2023, "AAKAR" by SAPTI was inaugurated in Ambaji. "AAKAR" is a testimony to the celebration and propagation of the transforming yet age-old tradition of stone carving in Gujarat and India as a whole. "AAKAR", through its unique concept as a retail outlet, showcases an array of stone forms, ranging from traditional to contemporary artifacts by bringing them closer to the general masses and admirers of stone craft. Designs at "AAKAR" have been developed by SAPTI students, its highly capable faculty members, and local artisans of Ambaji and Dhrangadhra while remaining rooted in our rich tradition and utility. "AAKAR" is soon going to venture in ecommerce, with a promise to deliver stone artifacts to its admirers on their doorstep. So far, "AAKAR" has showcased itself in the International Trade Promotion Organization - New Delhi, Flower Show- Ahmedabad, and Stone Mart - Jaipur, where it was received exceptionally well.

- 4. Enter the name of the Training Centre and Course details (6 months, etc.)
- 5. Enter your educational qualifications.
